Stop an Overdose SAVE ALIFEL

If you or someone you know uses opioids such as heroin or misuses prescription pain medications, please inquire with Tuscola Behavioral Health Systems (TBHS) for information on how to obtain a FREE lifesaving NARCAN kit.

When a person overdoses on opioids, they stop breathing. NARCAN may reverse the overdose, allowing the victim to breathe again. It is a safe antidote for an opioid overdose, and does not hurt a person if they have not taken opioids. The person MUST receive emergency medical treatment following the use of Narcan.
