



Stop an Overdose

SAVE A LIFE!

If you or someone you know uses opioids such as heroin or misuses prescription pain medications, please inquire with Tuscola Behavioral Health Systems (TBHS) for information on how to obtain a **FREE** lifesaving NARCAN kit.

When a person overdoses on opioids, they stop breathing. NARCAN may reverse the overdose, allowing the victim to breathe again. It is a safe antidote for an opioid overdose, and does not hurt a person if they have not taken opioids. The person **MUST** receive emergency medical treatment following the use of Narcan.

A person may be having an opioid overdose if they:

- ~ Are known to use opioids ~ Have clammy or pale skin
- ~ Are breathing slowly or not at all ~ Will not wake up, even when you shake them
- ~ Have lips or fingernails that are blue or gray colored
