Provides quality assurance/performance improvement training to TBHS staff. Ensures timely and accurate reporting of data and outcomes. Provides supervision and guidance to performance improvement staff. Assists with the Peer to Peer Committee. Represents TBHS on the MSHN Performance Improvement Committee. Demonstrates knowledge of and actively supports culturally competent, recovery based practices.
