VACANT POSITION AVAILABLE: Supports Coordinator/Case Manager

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Full or limited Michigan licensure (LMSW or LLMSW) as a Master's Social Worker preferred; consideration will be given to LPC, LBSW, and LLBSW candidates. Substance use experience and CADC credential desirable. Must have at least one year of clinical experience in treating or working with adults with serious mental illness is required. Valid driver's license and automobile insurance are required.

SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITY: Provides supports coordination/case management services to adults with severe and persistent mental illness, which includes assessment, person-centered planning, care coordination, discharge and after care planning, and a variety of other psychosocial services. Advocates and serves as a liaison with community supports and agencies. Provides service as a review of the individual's response to mental health treatment, including direct contact with individuals served. Position requires travel (agency vehicle available) and after hours on-call availability. Demonstrates knowledge of and actively supports culturally competent, recovery based practices.
